A few reminders for next week:

School Hours 8:05 am - 3:25 pm

To assist with getting every student in the building on time, starting Monday,

- Students may enter the building at 7:45 am.
- Students eating breakfast may enter the building at 7:35 am.
- Pre-K students may enter the building at 7:35 am.

If your student arrives after 8:05 you will need to walk them into the building and sign them for their safety.

Tardies will begin Monday if students are not in the building by 8:05 am. Please plan accordingly as we have over 166 carpool riders.

Tips for Carpool:

- Neighbors should consider carpooling together in the morning
- Could your student(s) walk or ride their bikes to school?
- Students should sit on the side of the car they will exit from
- Students should be ready to exit the car with backpacks in lap, lunch boxes ready to go, and know how to unbuckle and exit the car towards a sidewalk.

If your child is a car rider in the afternoon, you must have a carpool number. You may pick them up in the front office. Please practice learning your carpool number with your student so when called, they recognize their number.

Early dismissals should be completed prior to 3:00 pm.

Kindergarten students who are walkers must have a parent present to pick them up from the designated pick up spot. If a sibling or relative is picking them up, the teacher must be aware of this or they will not release the student.

Please notify the front office of transportation changes, teachers do not always see emails during the day.
